

International Field Practice in Tanzania

Offered by KCT

We are delighted that you have chosen to do your international field practice in Tanzania with KCT. This program is designed to be a rewarding and transformative experience—one that will broaden your perspective, be both challenging and fun, and support your personal as well as professional growth.

Program Structure

Your field practice begins with a two-week orientation. During this time, you will visit a variety of private and public institutions, gain insight into the local context, social structures, and available resources, be introduced to the field of social work in Tanzania and meet with the six different partner organizations where placements are available. You will also get an introductory lesson to the local language Kiswahili, as well as getting a chance to interact with the local communities in the area where your placement will be.

Our goal is to give you a broad overview of how social work is practiced here, preparing you to make the most of your placements.

After the orientation, you will begin your field practice with six weeks at your first placement. This will be followed by a week of field visits before you continue with another round of practice at a different placement. The final weeks of the program are dedicated to wrap-up field visits and an overall evaluation of your experience.

Placement options include organizations working in:

- Substance abuse & rehabilitation
- Community development & women's programs
- Education & empowerment
- Children and youth with disabilities/special needs
- Legal support
- Orphan care settings

By rotating placements, you will gain a deeper and more varied understanding of social work in the Tanzanian context.

To support you along the way, weekly supervision takes place every Friday with our team of supervisors. These sessions are a space for guidance, reflection, and encouragement as you navigate your field practice journey.

What is included

The program is structured to offer you comprehensive support during your international field practice, and the cost is 500 USD per month with a typical duration of 4 months (1 semester). The program fee includes;

Housing

Accommodation in a spacious shared house Utilities (electricity, water, gas) included Breakfast provided Cleaning and house help Night watchman for security Gardener Wi-Fi (first month included)
