2021 – introduction from the Head of Subject

During 2021, political science was subject to no less than three evaluations. The Swedish Research Council employed an international expert panel to evaluate the quality and social impact of political science in Sweden¹. The panel came to the overall conclusion that “Sweden has much to be proud of as regards the performance of its political scientists” (p. 59). To assess the quality of research the panel read and scored a random selection of publications from the different political science departments. Örebro received a mean score of 2.40 (0–4), beaten only by the University of Gothenburg (2.48) and Stockholm (2.55). The panel concluded that “size matters”, but also “as the examples of /.../ Örebro University /.../ show, it is also possible to produce *a good proportion of high-quality research outside the ‘big four’.*” (p. 39).

To evaluate the social impact we provided the panel with three cases. After reading the case descriptions, the panel gave Political Science at Örebro a mean score of 2.5 (0=No impact, 4=Excellent). Here, only the big four (Lund, Gothenburg, Stockholm, Uppsala) received higher mean scores. Örebro really exemplify one of the overall conclusions from the evaluation “that academic quality and policy impact in political science in general go hand-in-hand: departments whose research quality is high are also *successful in disseminating research to the public and to policy-making circles*” (p. 8)

In the University wide research evaluation ORU2020², political science was assessed by a panel chaired by Prof. B. Guy Peters. After reading a self-assessment and after a nice zoom-chat with representatives of the subject, they gave us a number of constructive comments to strengthen our research environment, including to be more visionary and continue to aim for quality rather than quantity. These helpful suggestions will form the basis for strategic discussions within the subject as well as with the HS Faculty and within the HUMUS during 2022. The overall conclusion, however, was that “*there are talented people in the Unit* and they should work to maximize their potential contributions to the discipline and the University.”

Finally, our educational programs and courses was evaluated by the HS Faculty. After a self-assessment that was commented by the Faculty board as “*very well conducted*” (anonymous source) and a second reporting (ALL subjects report at least twice) that was commented as “*exemplary*” (anonymous source), political science was given a green light. And that was not it, we also received the go-ahead to start a new master program in political science – starting Autumn 2022.

There is a lot to be said about evaluations; they don’t say everything, but they do say something!

Thank you all for the great work you do – in research, in teaching, in collaborating with the outside world, and in administration – and a special thanks to all of you who headed, contributed, or supported these evaluation processes!
