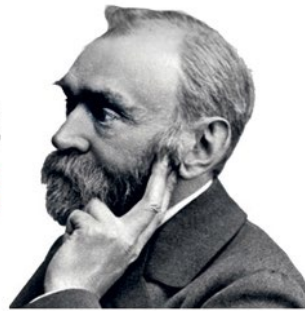


# ÖREBRO UNIVERSITY'S NOBEL DAY FESTIVITIES
