“ANALYSING AIR POLLUTION AND ITS MANAGEMENT THROUGH THE LENS OF THE UN SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT GOALS”

Dr Ben Williams research spans the broad field of air quality. He has worked on Horizon 2020 funded project Clair City, for a citizen led reduction of air pollution in cities; National Institute for Care Excellence to understand the impact of air pollution interventions on health; NERC funded bioaerosol modelling from intensive agriculture and he's currently seconded to the England Environment Agency to develop a next-generation UK-wide air quality monitoring network.

Ben Williams interests in emerging fields include the relationship between air pollution and SDGs and the identification and characterisation of microplastics in air.
