• Food	2.300 SEK
• Student housing	3.300 SEK*
• Cell phone	200 SEK
• Course material	800 SEK
• Local travel	300 SEK
• Leisure	600 SEK
• Miscellaneous	1.100 SEK
Total: 8600 SEK (around 850 € or 1000 \$)	

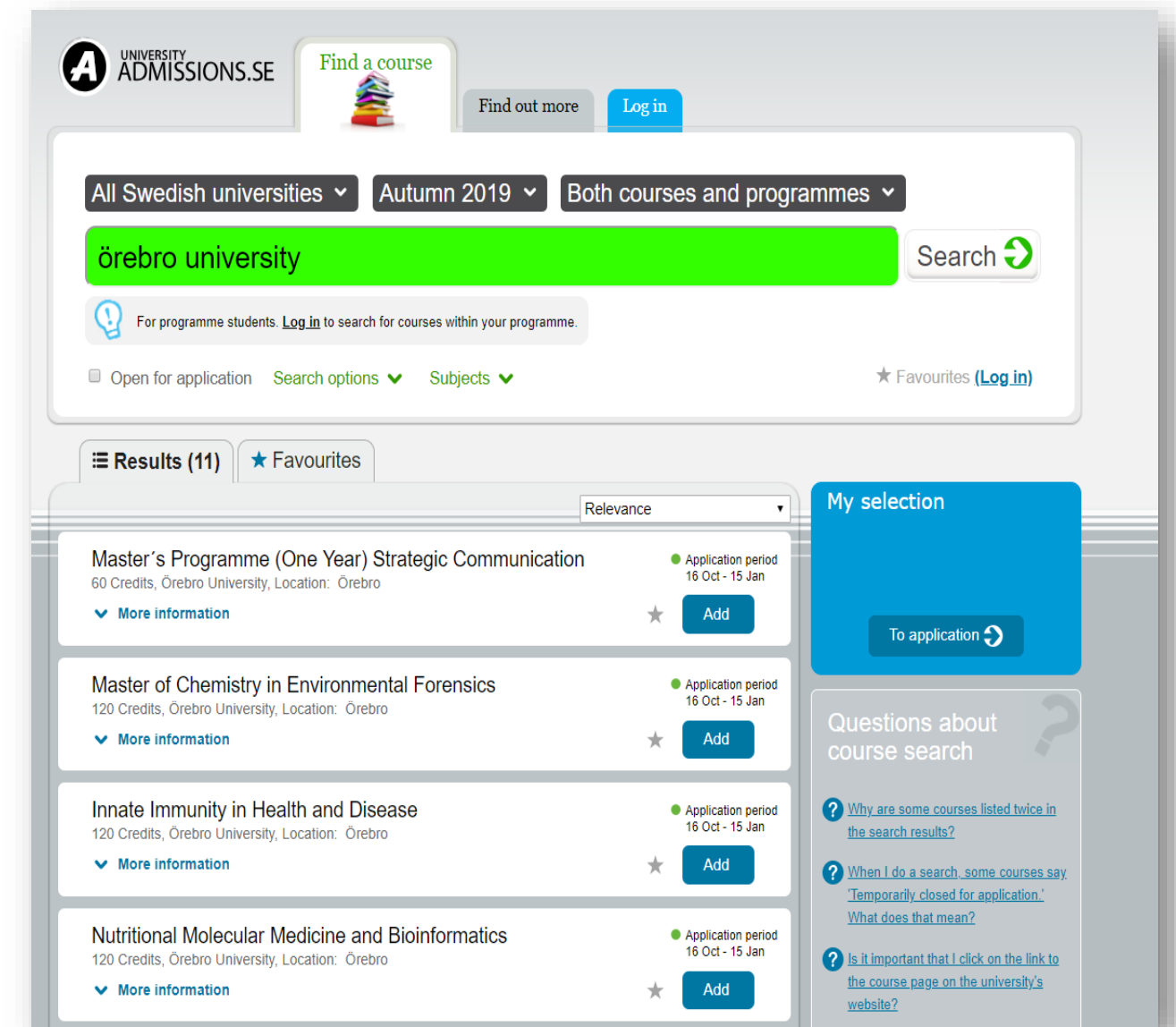
