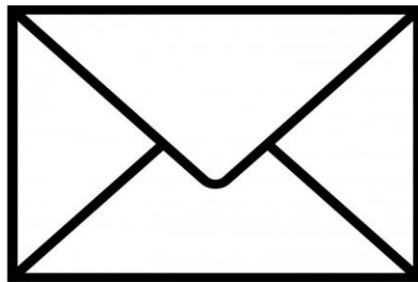

# Academic Information

## General information

- Autumn semester 2020: August 31 to January 17
  - No official breaks apart from public holidays
  - One semester= 20 weeks/30 ECTS credits
- About courses
  - 7,5 ECTS credits during 5 weeks = a full-time course
  - 7,5 ECTS credits during 10 or more weeks = a part-time course
  - Grades at ORU
    - Swedish grades U/Fail – G/Pass – VG/Pass with distinction
    - ECTS grades A – B – C – D – E – F (fail)
- Full time study = 40 hours/week
- Attending lessons

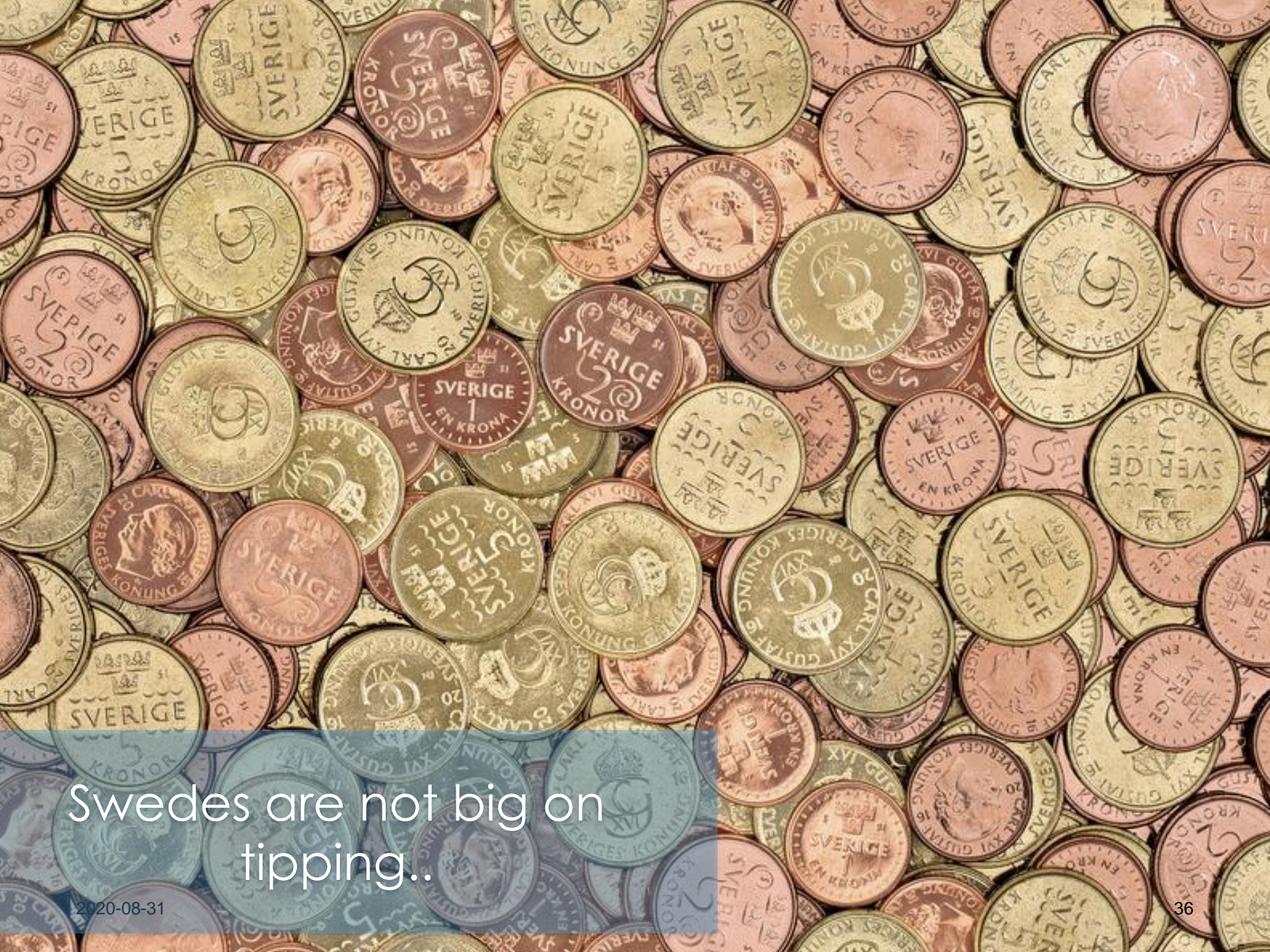
