

## Assessment at final review in Disability Research

The purpose of the final review is to effect a thorough run-through of all sub-studies in the thesis and the draft manuscript of the introductory chapter. The focus of the final review should be a constructive discussion in which the experts make suggestions for necessary revisions/improvements that are deemed important for the successful completion of a public defence or licentiate seminar. The final review is not an examination.

The doctoral student presents their completed and planned thesis work, which is then followed by a discussion, firstly with the experts and thereafter with all attendees. The seminar concludes with a discussion in private between the experts, doctoral student and supervisor(s). The final review is estimated to last about 2 hours, plus subsequent discussion. The final review is held in Swedish or English.

Experts give oral and written statements. The assessment in this protocol shall clearly state what measures are required before the thesis can be presented at the public defence.

This assessment form can be attached and taken into account in the proposal and decision on the public defence.
